GETTING STARTED

To get started the user will need the following:


- 1. The IP address of their PBI server or the DNS name, (friendly name), setup by their IT department.
 - a. IP Example <u>http://10.10.0.3</u>
 - b. DNS Name Example <u>http://svpbi</u>
- 2. The account user name and password.
 - a. PBI contains three distinct user types
 - i. **Standard** This account can create and set **Schedules**, create bell and paging **Zones**, view all **Devices**, play and upload **Sound** files, start and stop **Announcements**.
 - ii. Admin This account has all the <u>Standard</u> user abilities plus add and delete Devices, create
 Announcements, see and execute Intercom functions, under the Admin tab, start and stop services, add users, (standard & admin level only), view machine level information, Backup and Restore.
 - iii. **Master Admin** This account has all the Standard and Admin user abilities plus the ability to change the server Host name, IP, DNS, Time Zone and Time Server.
 - b. The default user names and passwords are:
 - i. Standard user phxuser
 - ii. Admin user pxhadmin –
 - iii. Master user phxma –
 - iv. Note: It is highly recommended the default passwords are changed once the system is turned over to the school.
- 3. PBI is a browser-based application. The software will function in any modern web browser. However, Chrome is recommended for the best user experience.





LOG IN


- 1. Launch the web browser
- 2. Type the *IP or DNS* name in the address field



- 3. Type the *user name* and *password* in the appropriate fields
- 4. Click the Login button



5. The browser will display the Welcome screen. The user name and user type will be displayed in the upper right corner.




PBI Log In
